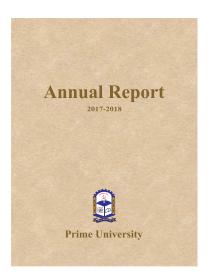

Prime University has created its permanent campus with all the necessary facilities for modern education having an easy access for people flooking from all directions of the Dhaka city and the country at large. Faculty of Business is an enriched faculty of Prime University. Now-a-days a great member of BBA and MBA degree holders from Business Administration Department of Prime University are employed in the top positions of the indigenous and multinational companies. Students who are studying in BBA and MBA programs are likely to have working opportunities in a wide range of professions like financial institutions, Government and non-government organizations, accounts department of commercial organizations, audit departments, taxes departments, administration etc. Thus, the students have been contributing their innovative power to bring changes in different fields of human endeavors.

Here students get all kinds of facilities, being enrolled in BBA and MBA department in Prime University. There are worthy and experienced fulltime teachers in the University. Besides, teachers from IBA, Dhaka University, Jahangirnagar University, Rajshahi University and Jagannath University are teaching as part-time teachers in the University. In every semester, workshop, seminar, presentation, etc. are arranged in order to increase students' confidence level to make them worthy for the competitive world.

Faculty of Engineering is one of the most important faculties of Prime University. In this age of technological revolution, engineering education is an important issue. In the era of competition, Computer Science and Engineering, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering have become important in all sectors of education. Now-a-days technology based companies need Software developer, Web developer, IT manager, Computer programmer, Graphic designer, Computer administrator, Computer system analyst, Database admin. Besides, every ministry has opened Information Technology cell these days. There Engineers from CSE, EEE and ETE get priority. Students of Prime University receive BSc degree from these departments, then have opportunity to get the work in domestic and various foreign organizations including BCS cadre. Many of them get job opportunity in world class organizations like IBM, Microsoft, Google and Samsung. Besides, many students get the job as IT professionals with good salary in various corporate organizations including mobile phone companies after their completion of BSc In this faculty, more than 50 regular teachers and a good many part-time teachers from BUET, DUET, CHUET, RUET, KUET and DU have been rendering their valuable services here.

Prime University's Faculty of Law is a well-known and important faculty in Bangladesh. At present, one of the most prestigious professions in the world is Law. Prime University is one of the most notable universities which are currently engaged in the field of law education. On the basis of merit and competence, students get the opportunity to study here. To teach the learners Law, here a strong panel of teachers including professors of law, lawyers, judges, and barristers has been formed. Besides, experienced teachers from

Dhaka University, Rajshahi University, Jagannath University and Islamic University, Kushtia are working as part time teachers. Arranging seminars, symposiums and visiting court are the regular practices of this department. Students after being graduated from this department have both theoretical and practical knowledge that make them worthy lawyers. Moreover, students have access to use different collection of books on Law at Prime University Library. It is, no doubt, a grand success as nearly100% students who received education on Law have been qualified in Bar Council Examination over the decade. At present, thousands of lawyers including bar association lawyers receiving Law degree from this University are working in the highest court of the country. Distinguished students are also working as judges and magistrates in the judiciary.

English Department of Prime University makes important contributions to English teaching and it's BA (Hons) and MA programs are gaining increasing popularity day by day. Following teaching strategies, students are taught through well-designed courses and lesson plans. Students having completed Honors and Masters from this department have been working in the important posts of government and nongovernment organizations with utmost devotion. Along with the regular teachers of the Department, part time teachers from Dhaka University, Jahangirnagar University and Islamic University, Kushtia are also working here.

Department of Education of Prime University plays an important role in the country's education system. Trained teachers are very much important to make the primary and secondary level education system more stable and inclusive. Keeping this in mind, BEd and MEd courses are run in Prime University. These courses are of one-year duration and conducted as weekend programs. Their main purpose is to develop human resource and produce skilled manpower. This department provides qualitative and contemporary education by the experienced and skilled teachers in BEd and MEd programs at a low cost. Besides, overseas students are studying in Prime University in BEd and MEd programs.

Prime University Language School (PULS) is a wing of Prime University, working with a motto to increase students' language skill in different foreign languages. PULS has promising experienced and skilled teachers, who are relentlessly working to make the students groomed through imparting research based knowledge on language teaching. In this age of globalization, the knowledge of foreign language has been considered as extra advantage that helps an individual to fit in this competitive world. Different languages including English, Japanese, Chinese and French are taught here. Besides, PULS provides Special English Language Course for the foreign students.

Prime University has 21 various types of club and through these clubs, students get the chance to enter a wide range of cultural and social activities to develop their academic talent. The notable clubs are Debating Club, Language Club,

Cultural Club, Sports Club (Outdoor), Sports Club (Indoor), Photography Society, Health Club, Career and Job Placement Society, Computer Hardware Club, Computer Programming Club, Moot Court Society, Volunteer Service Club, Software Engineering Club, BNCC and Scout, Book Society, International Student Society, Science and Engineering Club, Business Studies Club, Quiz Competition Club, Drama Society.

Laboratory is essential for Engineering Studies. The Faculty of Engineering of Prime University has 30 different well-equipped labs for students including Telecommunication Engineering Laboratory, Circuit Laboratory, Digital Electronics Laboratory, Computer Laboratory, Electrical Mechanical Laboratory, Microwave Engineering Laboratory, Software Engineering Laboratory, Operating System Laboratory, VLSI Laboratory, Industrial and Power Electronics Laboratory, Digital Signal Processing Laboratory, Data Communication Laboratory, Computer Networking Laboratory, Physics Laboratory, Chemistry Laboratory, Web Program Laboratory, etc.

Prime University has been an ideal place of education for both the national and international students. Students from different countries are studying at Prime University in various programs. Overseas students from several countries like Nepal, Somalia, Zimbabwe, Ghana are having admission at Prime University. The International Student Affairs Desk has been established at Prime University to provide all kinds of uninterrupted supports to the foreign students. Academic advisor has also been appointed to look after their wellbeing. Besides, overseas students are provided highly secured accommodation facilities.

Various types of scholarships and financial grants are offered to the students of Prime University. Poor talented students, freedom fighters' children and grandchildren, physically disabled students, brother-sister (1 person), husbandwife (1 person), recognized player, artistand tribal students get up to 100% waiver of tuition fees. Apart from this, 5% additional waiver is offered to girls' tuition fees.

Prime University's Debating Society (PUDS) started its journey in 2007. It participates in television debates which are organized by TIB, National Human Rights Organization, National Debating Federation, Bangladesh, and British Council. Besides, it takes part in debating contest organized by public and private Universities. Arranging debating competition in every semester inside the University is a regular practice of the PUDS. Students of the University participate in various activities like shows, debates, and social consciousness related debate etc. under different ministrien of as the young representatives. In the library of Prime University, there is a special corner of books on debating. Students can have the access to read these books from the library. Every year a budget allocation is made to the debate committee by the University authority.

Cultural activities being essential for the students, these are held regularly at the University. Students get opportunities to develop themselves by participating in these cultural activities. Prime University has a cultural committee to handle these activities fairly. Moreover, Prime University organizes various events including annual picnic, excursions and industrial visits for students.

Prime University Journal is an international peer reviewed journal. Prime University publishes scholarly journal twice a year aiming at creating a research based society. Besides, the University publishes an annual magazine called 'The Ray' where students, teachers, staffs and officials of the University have the access to writing. Every year Prime University publishes its Annual Report that contains a brief of most of the activities of University round the year.

The students of Prime University always prove their worth in national and international games and sports. Besides, they always participate in different

indoor, outdoor games, especially with other public and private universities. 'Clemon Indoor Uni Cricket', 'Inter University Cricket', 'Ulab Fair Play Cup' are notably mentioned.

Prime University has a rich library with modern facilities. The University has a spacious reading room with about 29,000 books, 30000 electronics books, and 3000 magazines. Students can have all the famous books of the world, getting help from e center that Prime University has established, considering the benefits of students and teachers.

Admission Statement

Above 1400 students were admitted in the year of 2017-2018.

Summer Semester-2017

In Summer Semester-2017, 467 students got admitted, among them 85 students took admission in MBA while 43 in BBA, 163 in BSc in EEE, 74 students in BSc in CSE, 19 in BA (Hons) in English, 19 of them got admitted in MA in English, 13 in LLB Hons, 14 in LLM (Preliminary & Final), 07 in LLM (Regular), 19 in BEd and 11 in MEd.

Out of 467 newly admitted students in Summer-2017 Semester, 81.47% were male and remaining 18.53% were female.

Fall Semester-2017

In Fall Semester-2017, 423 students got admitted, among them 77 students in MBA while 63 in BBA, 115 in BSc EEE, 52 in BSc in CSE, 20 in BA (Hons) in English, 18 in MA in English, 17 in LLB Hons, 11 in LLB (Preliminary & Final), 18 in LLM (Preliminary & Final), 14 in LLM (Regular), 15 in BEd and 03 in MEd.

Out of 423 newly admitted students in Fall Semester-2017, 74.30% were male and remaining 25.70% were female.



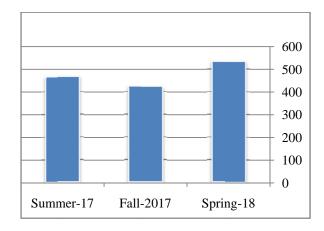
A view of the admission office

Spring Semester-2018

In Spring Semester-2018, 534 students got admitted, among them 87 students in MBA while 67 in BBA, 134 in BSc in EEE, 82 in BSc in CSE, 28 in BA (Hons) in English, 09 in MA in English, 29 in LLB Hons, 16 in LLM (Preliminary & Final), 09 in LLM (Regular), 56 in BEd and 17 in MEd.

Out of 534 newly admitted students in Spring Semester-2018, 72.35% were male and remaining 27.65% were female.

The academic year 2017-2018 is an eventful one in the life of the Prime University as it is studded with the observance of a good number of occasions as described briefly in the next pate:

Highlights of 2017-2018

National Mourning Day, 2017 Observed:

Prime University observed National Mourning Day, 2017 paying tribute to the father of the nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman on his 42nd anniversary of martyrdom. Mir Shahabudddin, Chairman of the Board of Trustees, Prime University was present as the Chief Guest in the discussion session while Prof Dr M Abdus Sobhan, Vice Chancellor of Prime University presided over the program. Among others, Senior Vice Chairman of BOT, Md Ashraf Ali, Vice Chairman of BOT, Nripen Maitra, Treasurer of BOT, Md Mamun Sobhan, Treasurer of the University, Prof M Arshad Ali, Deans of different faculties, Registrar of the University M Abdul Jabber, Controller of the Examinations Md Nur Hossain Talukder, Heads and faculty members of different Departments together with many students and university personnel were present in the program. On the occasion, Chief Guest urged the present generation to be regenerated with the spirit of Liberation War and engage themselves to complete the unfinished task of Bangabandhu. After the discussion session, Chairman of the BOT and Vice Chancellor of the University distributed prizes among the winners of essay competition on Bangabandhu's life. At the end of the program, a Doa Mahfil was arranged at the University premises to say prayer for eternal peace of Bangabandhu and martyr members of his family.

Observance of Intellectual Martyrs Day:

Prime University observed the Intellectual Martyrs Day on 14 December 2017 with due solemnity to pay deep tributes to those enlightened and precious personalities of the nation who were brutally murdered almost on the eve of the victory of Bangladesh against the marauding occupation forces of Pakistan. On the occasion the black flag was hoisted by the Vice Chancellor Prof Dr M Abdus Sobhan in front of the University at 6:00 am and then Prime University family gathered at the Memorial and placed floral wreaths to honor the martyred intellectuals. A discussion program was also held at the University permanent campus where the Chairman of BOT, Mir Shahabuddin graced the program as the Chief Guest and the Vice Chancellor of the University was the Chair of the occasion.

Celebration of Victory Day:

Prime University celebrated the 47th Victory Day paying homage to the martyrs of the war of liberation of 1971. The University commemorated the day with different programs including hosting of the national flag, discussion session and

cultural functions. Special prayers were offered seeking divine blessing for the martyrs of the Liberation War.

Mir Shahabuddin, Chairman, BOT started the program by hoisting the national flag while the national anthem was played. A discussion program was held on the occasion. Finally, a colorful cultural program was also arranged by the student artists of the University.

Observance of International Mother Language Day:

Prime University observed Mahan Shaheed Dibash (Martyrs Day) and International Mother Language Day and paid glowing tribute to the martyrs of the language movement on 21 February 2018. To mark the day the University chalked out elaborate program including rally, placing wreaths, discussion session and cultural program at the University Shaheed Minar premises. The Vice Chancellor Prof Dr M Abdus Sobhan and all high officials, faculty members, officers and students brought out a procession and gathered at the Shaheed Minar to place floral wreaths. University's Cultural Committee organized a discussion program where Mir Shahabuddin, Chairman, Board of Trustees of the University was present as the Chief Guest and the Vice Chancellor presided. A cultural program was also arranged where the students rendered patriotic choral songs which went down exceedingly well with the audience.

Participation in the Procession of Celebrating UNESCO's Recognition of 7th March Speech of the Father of the Nation:

DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

Overview:

The Department of English at Prime University is one of the live Departments belonging to the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences. The Department started its journey in 2002 in order to impart the knowledge of Language and Literature at tertiary level. The academic activities of this Department are conducted by the faculty members who have excellent academic knowledge and experience. The Applied Linguistics/ELT stream concentrates on the practical and theoretical skills together. The concentration on technological approaches to language learning and acquisition is to equip all students with writing, research and analytical skills.

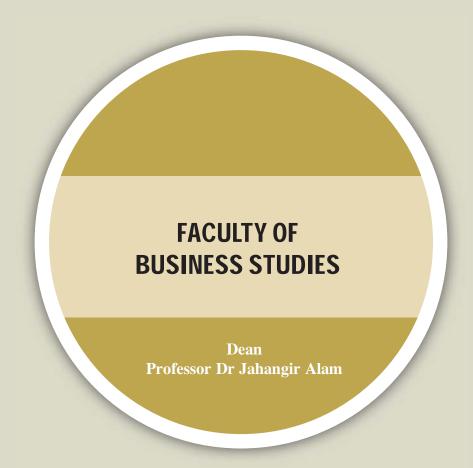
A Seminar on Importance of Educational Research Held at Prime University:

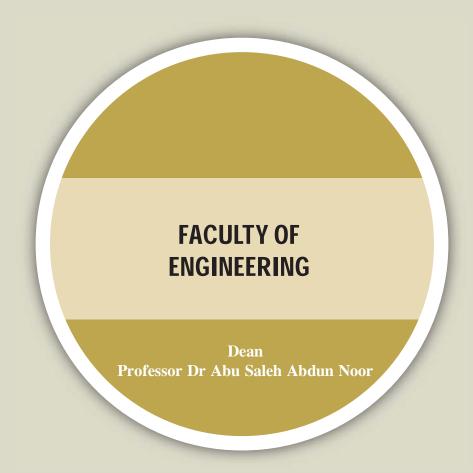
Seminar on 'Contemporary Issues of the Banking Industry of Bangladesh':

Student Hunting Tour Held in the Department of CSE:

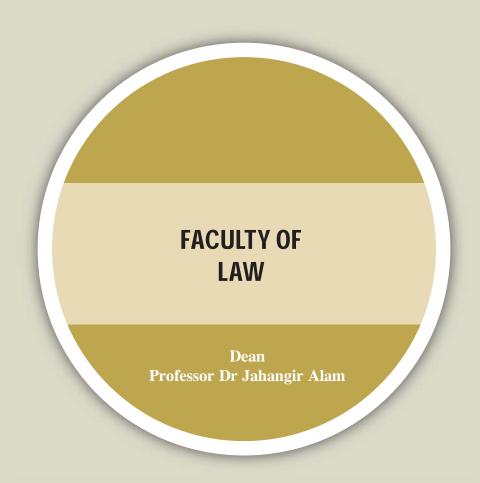
The student hunting tour for the department of CSE was held on 12 June 2018 at the office room of the Shyamoli Ideal Polytechnic Institute, Mohammadpur,

OFFICE OF THE CONTROLLER OF EXAMINATIONS

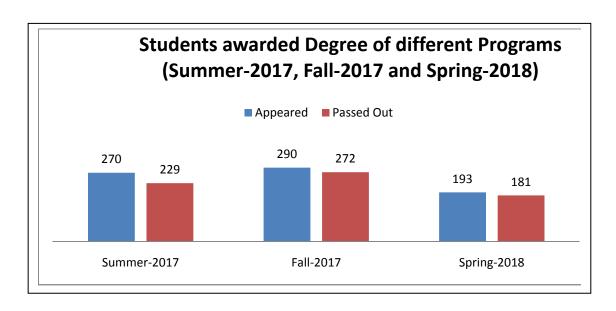

Library is an important part of every higher educational institution and usually serves two complementary purposes: (1) to provide the support service for the study of the course curricula and (2) to support the faculty member and students on research and development activities. A library is regarded as the storehouse of knowledge and the resource centre of all academic activities of a university. Since the very inception of the university, Prime University Library has been working to achieve the goal of the university. Prime university library cares for learning, teaching and research activities through easy access and use of its large number of printed collections, e-book and online resources. Prime University Library has a floor area of 2500 sq. ft. Prime University Library is decorated with modern & suitable student reading room &Wi-Fi connection. In 2017-2018, the Library continued to enrich its collections and services by purchasing and subscribing print and electronic resources and to develop and maintain the required technical infrastructure for accessing these resources.

Collection Development

- Continued subscription to more than 35000 online journals and databases
- Membership of "Research4Life" a resourceful e-resource provider.
- 1200 e-books downloaded free from the unsubscribed websites.

Resources

Library is a growing part of Prime University. The collection of Prime University library is increasing day by day. At present, the library has a collection of about 29,000 books, 630 reports 950 Journals. The resources of the library attempts at fulfiling the requirement of the programs offered by the University and also meet and the general interest of the users. All collections are classified, catalogued and displayed using international standard. The library preserves books, magazines, dissertations, newspapers, journals, audiovisual materials etc, covering academic programs like English, Business Studies, Law, Education, Electrical & Electronic Engineering (EEE) and Computer Science and Engineering (CSE).

E-Resources

Prime university is a member of the UDL (UGC Digital Library) with the access to 5(five) e-resources in the form of websites under the HEQEP project of UGC. The e-resource providers are ACM Digital Library, Emerald 194, IEEE (ASPP+POP ALL), Wiley, JESTOR (Archive + Annual Access). Users can search, read and download e-resources from these subscribed websites. Now Prime University has the membership of **RemoteXs** to access the UDL e-resources from anywhere by its users.

Facilities and Services:

- The students are allowed to borrow three books and keep them in their possession for fifteen days
- Faculty members, executives and staff can borrow books according to their demand for a whole semester
- An individual can borrow reference books for two hours
- Students can borrow dissertation for two hours
- Students can borrow CD/DVD for a week
- UDL E-resources are available for searching, reading and downloading
- The reading room is well decorated and air conditioned
- National and international magazines and journals are subscribed by the library.

Library Hours

The library remains open from 9:00 am to 5:30 pm from Sunday to Wednesday, 9:00 am to 7:00 pm on Thursday, 8:00 am to 7:00 pm on Friday and 10:30 am to 6:30 pm on Saturday, except the holidays declared by the University authority.

Budget Allocation

In the financial year 2017-2018, a sum of BDT 17,66,443 (Taka Seventeen lac sixty six thousand and four hundred forty three only) was spent for Library (except salary and honorarium) from the University budget for purchasing books and the development of the library.

PRIME UNIVERSITY EMPLOYEES' WELFARE FUND

The Prime University is an academic body corporate whose main objective is to render prime knowledge among its students flocking from different corners of the country. To cater to the academic needs of these students and to make them capable enough to face the emerging challenges of the global competition, the concerted efforts of all the employees- faculties, executives and staff of the University- is of paramount importance. To enlist the whole hearted dedication of the employees there should be, in addition to psychological and mental support for them, a prospect of minimum financial assistance that could stand in good stead in times of their grave emergencies. It is with this end in view that the authority of the university has instituted a Welfare Fund for its employees in the name and style 'Prime University EmployeesWelfare Fund'.

Financial assistance is granted from the Welfare Fund to the employee who has been incapacitated physically or mentally or to the successor(s) of the employee who dies during the continuance of his/her employment. The Fund may also be utilized for granting suitable relief to the employees in case of grave illness or serious injuries requiring hospitalization and prolonged treatment.

THE UNIVERSITY BUILDING PROJECT

The Prime University Main Campus building is a modern architectural structure with provision for all state of the art facilities for a university. This is a 10 storied building with a basement for accommodating 50 vehicles and for providing some other facilities. Each floor has an average area of 13,000 sft. and the total area is 1,46,000 sft.

The estimated cost of the building is Tk. 47,93,68,383.00 and Tk. 39,33,41,811.00 has been spent including Tk. 4,33,41,811.00 in the last financial year i.e. 1st July/2016 to 30th June/2018.

A renowned consultant firm, Design Associates Ltd. has planned & designed the building and the Consultant performs the responsibility of full time supervision to ensure the quality of the work. The construction works are being done under the execution of a team consisting of a qualified and highly experienced Project Manager, two well experienced Sub-Asst. Engineers and six other related staffs experienced in their relevant field.

The main gate and boundary wall construction have already been completed. The finishing works of basement to level-8 have been completed and the finishing works of level-9 to 11 are in progress.

- 200 KW DESCO connection has already been established. The procurement and installation of the following have also been completed:
- (i) 1000 KVA Sub-Station: Equipments of the Sub-Station are placed in position and internal connection is completed. Power supply of the campus building is being provided through the Sub-Station.
- (ii) 500 KVA Generator: Generator is already functioning as and when required.
- (iii) 1000Kg Capacity 3 Nos Lift: 3 Nos 1000 Kg capacity lifts have been installed & are running smoothly.
