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
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

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The 2nd Convocation of Prime University was held on April 24, 2016 at Bangabandhu International Conference Centre. Nurul Islam Nahid, MP, the hon'ble Education Minister, People's Republic of Bangladesh presided over the convocation ceremony as the representative of the hon'ble President

of the People's Republic of Bangladesh and Chancellor of the University Md. Abdul Hamid. Dr. Anisuzzaman, Emeritus Professor of the University of Dhaka delivered the Convocation Speech. Prof. Dr. M Abdus Sobhan, the Vice Chancellor and Prof. Dr. M Abul Hossain Sikder, Pro-Vice Chancellor of the university made speech in the convocation ceremony. Engineer Md. Towhidur Rahman, Chairman of BoT and Md. Ashraf Ali, Senior Vice Chairman of BoT of the university also spoke on the occasion. Sheikh Kabir Hossain, Chairman, Association of Non Govt. Universities graced the program as the special guest.

A total of 9455 graduates received degrees in this convocation. Five students received Chancellor's gold medal, five were honored through the gold medal of Chairman, BoT and six were awarded Vice Chancellor's gold medal.

In his speech, the hon'ble Education Minister said that only educated population could ensure democracy, social, political and cultural rights of the people. The Minister urged the university authority not to limit education to only certificate awarding affair but also to provide effective and realistic education to produce good human beings in their practical life. He said that the higher education based

on science and technology was the driving force of the economy of the country. He mentioned that the present Govt. under the leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina was very much intent to build Bangladesh as a modern and digital Bangladesh. His speech over, he conferred the degrees on the graduates.

Convocation Speaker Dr. Anisuzzaman said to the graduates that their degree would be meaningless if it did not make them capable to differentiate between justice and injustice. A human being knows how to love others, be encouraged to sacrifice for others, refrain himself from any kind of corruptions by dint of education wherever he comes from, he added. He also urged the students to go ahead with such kind of values and moral principles of education so that their family, society and even the country could feel pride and glory in them.

The Chairman of the Board of Trustee (BoT), Engineer Md. Towhidur Rahman, stated that convocation was a very important and sacred occasion. The graduates would soon enter into the professional life. On this day in 1952, the valiant sons of Bangladesh Salam, Rafiq, Barkat, Jabbar, Shafiq and many others laid down their lives on the streets of Dhaka to establish Bangla as one of the state languages of erstwhile Pakistan. The sacrifices of the *Bangalee* youths to uphold the glory and honor of the mother tongue are unprecedented in the world history. As the

International Mother Language Day, it is now observed all over the world. Prime university family also remembered the martyrs of The Language Movement with utmost respect and reverence. The program started at 7.30 am with hoisting the national flag in front of the Prime University building by the teachers, officers, students and employees of the university. A procession was brought out in the morning from the university premises to

commemorate the sacrifices of the martyrs in accompaniment of the celebrated song, "*Amar Bhaiyer Rakte Rangano...*" (colored in the blood of my brother...).

The Language Martyrs and their contributions were remembered with utmost respect and honor and tributes were paid to them by placing floral wreath at the memorial. A discussion program was held at the

University premises where the speakers shared their opinions and recalled the contributions of the martyrs. The cultural committee of Prime University arranged a colorful program to observe the Shaheed Dibash and International Mother Language Day. Students,

teachers and executives of the university participated in the program. The audience enjoyed the whole program with a pledge to uphold the status of our Bengali language forever.

Bongabondhu's Birth Day and National Children's Day Celebrated at Prime University

The Prime University celebrated Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's birthday and National Children's Day. The university organized a discussion meeting on the life of Bangabandhu and a doa mahfil seeking divine blessings for the departed souls of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and his dear and near ones who embraced martyrdom on August 15, 1975 and for peace, progress and prosperity of the country. The Vice-Chancellor in his speech said that in his short life Bangabandhu contributed a lot including the achievement of independence of Bangladesh. Mir Shahbuddin, the Member of the Board of Trustees, Prime University in his speech said that on this day in 1920, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman was born at Tungipara in Gopalganj district. The day is a glorious and important day in our nation's history. Bangladesh emerged as an independent country because of Bangabandhu's struggle and sacrifice. There is a lot to learn from his life, he added. Treasurer of the University Prof. M. Arshad Ali said that the Pakistani rulers imprisoned Sheikh Mujib many times and he had to remain in jail

for over a decade for leading various national movements. This is very sad that our greatest leader was killed along with most of his family members in a military coup on August 15 in 1975. Some students also took part in the discussion. The program was ended with reciting a poem 'Bongabondhur Jonmadine' composed and recited by Md. Mostafijur Rahman, Sr. Lecturer of the Department of Law.
